# Annual Report from the Treasurer

**By Greg Dyer, Treasurer 2015–2016**

**Statistics:** The Goodyear Ski Club, Inc. (Club) ended their fiscal year (Year) on March 31, 2016. The Club had available assets of \$43,025.76, which is a decrease of \$523.84 or 1.2%. A complete documentation of club income and expense by category is published on page 8 of this newsletter.

**Membership:** We ended our fiscal year with 181 members, a decrease of 15 members. There were some new members, mainly brought in by the day and weeklong ski trips.

**Ski Activities:** These activities showed a gain of \$2019.50 for the calendar year. However, if you add in a refund made in April 2016 for the Winter Park trip and the refund made during the Banff trip, the ski activities would show a loss. The member appreciation trip to Holimont was supplemented by \$394.74 from the treasury.

**Social Events:** These events showed a loss of \$504.91. Two events made money: the swap shop made \$1365.67; the wine tour made \$35.50. The swap shop made approximately \$1219 less than in 2014.

**Increased Expenses:** Officer reimbursements increased by \$255 from the prior year. One officer did not take a club sponsored ski trip, so was unable to take all of the officer reimbursement.

It might be prudent to price our ski trips to cover more of the costs and to change or cut back on some costs for the social events.

I've appreciated the opportunity to be the treasurer of the Club. It has been a learning opportunity for me. We have a very dedicated board that is a pleasure to work with. Thanks to John Vorhies for his ongoing help with this position.
